



RULES FOR HAPPY LAP CRUISING AT LAKESIDE

HAPPY LAPS **ARE NOT HOT LAPS** or TEST LAPS

Ensure that your car has been properly serviced

Happy Laps are for family cruising NOT performance driving, so:

- Any car-to-car contact is an instant stop for the session.
- Any car going off the track is an instant stop for the session.
- >1 second of tyre smoke is an instant stop for the session.

General Rules

- **Enter and Exit the track ONLY through the designated areas.**
- **No helmets are to be worn by anybody.**
- No unregistered or trailered cars are permitted on the track for Happy Laps.
- No Cars Fitted with aftermarket Roll Cages.
- All cars must have current registration and plates must not be obscured.
- Drivers may be breath tested—anyone reading more than 0.00 will be banned from the track.
- Lakeside staff will be in attendance to ensure observance of conditions.
- **Lakeside will name and shame drivers who push the limits and cause a session to be cancelled.**
- Windows should be half up.
- Keep all parts of your body inside the car at all times.
- Any external mounted cameras must have a second tether attached to a separate part of the car.

Tyres and fluids:

- Correct tyre pressures are very important. Consult a specialist if you are in any doubt about which pressure you should have set.
- Please ensure tyre pressures are correctly adjusted BEFORE arrival at the track.
- There are no facilities at the venue for tyre inflation.
- Check all fluids and ensure correct.

Before you arrive, remove all loose objects from the car and boot, check under seats as well.
